SUMMER READING ADVENTURE LOG

AN ADULT SUMMER READING [CHOOSE YOUR OWN] ADVENTURE FROM THE ALOHA COMMUNITY LIBRARY

Make your way from the isolation of the “Start Here” hex tile to the safety of the keep in the northeast “Finish” hex tile. Complete a hex tile’s listed challenge to advance one space to any adjacent hex tile. Achievements are cumulative—for example, one must have read four (4) books total to enter the “Read Four Books” space, not ten (10) books total. Three intrepid adventurers will be selected at random at the end of summer to receive a prize for completing their journey, with increased chance of reward for those who choose to **read beyond the beaten path.**

Read one book – Write the title below! A completed audiobook counts as a book “read” in all cases!

Read two books – Write the title of the 2nd book you finished!

Read three books – Write the title of the 3rd book you finished!

Read four books – Write the title of the 4th book you finished!

Read five books – Write the title of the 5th book you finished!

Read six books or finish a podcast series – Write the title of the 6th book you read or podcast series you finished!

Finish the latest novel in an ongoing series – Hopefully this one won’t be a bridge to nowhere, write the title below!

Read a novel originally written in a language other than one you speak – Write the title below!

Read a graphic novel or manga – Try [this search](https://bit.ly/38ho7Ym) (<https://bit.ly/38ho7Ym>) in the WCCLS catalog for a start, then write the title of the manga or graphic novel you finished!

Read at the park – You may be surprised by the number of parks and trails in your neighborhood. Check out <http://www.thprd.org/parks-and-trails/find-park> and write down the name of the park you visited!

Finish a “Little Free Library” book – Naturally, to complete this one, you’ll also have to **Visit a “Little Free Library.”** Find one near you, here <https://littlefreelibrary.org/ourmap/> and write the name of the book you finished (or leave a check mark if you only paid a visit)!

Complete an ebook or webnovel – visit <https://www.wccls.org/ebooks> or <https://www.webnovel.com/> and write the title of the book you finished!

Write a review – Write and attach a review of one of the books you read this summer to this sheet!

Listen to an oral storyteller – Check out <https://themoth.org/stories> or <https://storycorps.org/stories/> or find a local storyteller event and write the name of the storyteller you listened to!

Read a speculative fiction novel – The spirit of “Read Beyond the Beaten Path” lies at the heart of Fantasy and Science Fiction; write the title of a Science Fiction or Fantasy Novel you read!

Play a story driven video game – Video games are as powerful a storytelling medium as film or novels. Try these BAFTA winning games to start—look for “story” and “narrative” winners at <https://bit.ly/3OPFAHN> and write the name of a game you played!

Visit a library book shop or sale corner – Shameless plug for our own sale corner located at the front of the Aloha Community Library, but you may love [The Book Corner](#) at Beaverton City Library or [Second Edition Resale](#) at Cedar Mill Library. *Check here if you pay a visit!*

Share a book – Interpret this one how you will, but every book finds new life in the hands of a new reader. Recommend a book to a friend or unload your bursting shelves on local Little Free Libraries and check here:

Complete an audio book – Try our “Always Available Audiobooks” selection courtesy of WCCLS at <https://wccls.overdrive.com/collection/1009264> and be sure to record any that you finish in the “Read One Book” through “Read Six Books” spaces!

Listen to an episode of a fiction podcast – Following a narrative podcast from beginning to end can be an incredible time commitment, *check here if you gave one a shot* and be sure to write the name of any series you finish on the sixth line!

Play a tabletop roleplaying game – Try one of our Take & Game kits while supplies last! Write the name of your favorite game that you played below!
