WCCLS

- Funding and Governance items voted on:
 - Minimum hours open per week 45 hours
 - 1 city voted no, 6 cities voted yes
 - All 3 nonprofits voted yes
 - o 10 cent library levy increase
 - 1 city voted no, 6 cities voted yes
 - All 3 nonprofits voted yes
 - o Centralized collection management and interlibrary loans
 - 1 city voted no, 6 cities voted yes
 - 2 nonprofits voted yes, ACLA voted no
 - o ACLA wanted to make a statement by voting no
 - WCCLS did not provide any details of how this would work
 - This removes a very valuable component of librarian's work to cater to their local community
